

MARCIA KASH ~ AUTHOR

Marcia trained as an actor at the Drama Centre and began her career at the Royal Court Theatre in London, England.

Working solo, Marcia was commissioned to write *Discovering Elvis* for Lunchbox Theatre in Calgary. It has been widely produced throughout Canada and the U.S. Translated into French (A La Recherche D'Elvis) it was nominated for a Les Masques theatre award for Best New Play and has enjoyed numerous productions

throughout Quebec. Her drama *For This Moment Alone* received its premiere in 2011 at Theatre Aquarius and was subsequently published by Dramatists Play Service. It has since been produced numerous times.

Together with collaborator Mary Colin Chisholm, Marcia wrote the screenplay, *A Belly Full*, which received two Writers First awards from Telefilm Canada. It is currently in development as feature film. Adapted into a stage play ABF premiered at The Mill in the UK in 2019 and then in Canada in 2020.

In addition to writing and acting, Marcia is also an accomplished theatre director with over 100 credits ranging from new works to major musicals.



DOUGLAS E. HUGHES ~ AUTHOR

Douglas has been a professional actor since 1979 and has appeared in theatres across Canada and in the U.S. He spent 13 seasons with the Shaw Festival in Niagaraon-the-Lake, Ontario, and another 3 at the Stratford Festival. In 2015, Doug wrote two short plays for the Toronto Symphony Orchestra's Decades series, *Debussy: At Sea* and *The Talking Cure*. He has also written two novels, *The Poor Player* and its sequel, *The Shaming of the True*. He makes his home in Toronto.

Marcia Kash and Douglas E. Hughes began their collaboration in 1991 with the highly successful *Who's Under Where*? which has been translated into ten languages and performed in over 300 productions across 16 countries. Together, they went on to write the popular whodunnit *A Party to Murder* in 1996, the hilarious period comedy *Too Many Cooks* in 2003, and *Jack of Diamonds*, which was nominated for the PGC Tom Hendry Award for Best Comedy in 2013. Their award-winning play *Something Fishy*, which premiered at the Lighthouse Festival, earned them the Tom Hendry Award for Best New Comedy the following year. All five works were published by Samuel French Inc. (now Concord Theatricals) and have achieved widespread acclaim. Their meta whodunnit *Deadline* premiered at The Human Race Theatre in Dayton, Ohio, in late 2022 and was subsequently published by Broadway Licensing in New York City. Additionally, *Jack of Diamonds* was adapted into a screenplay and became a finalist in the international Big Break screenwriting competition. Currently, Marcia and Douglas are working on a new psychological thriller titled *Succour*:

JESSICA BAZAN ~ DRESSER


